## PERSONAL PRAYERS

## CLOSER TO GOD

Ask 2-3 people to share about their “Closer to God” time. How have they grown and how can your group pray for them.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What insight, principle, or observation from Sunday did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain.
- What do you think heaven will be like? What are you looking forward to the most?
- Does eternal life bring you hope or anxiety? Explain.
- How do you view life differently knowing that you are a citizen of Heaven? Does it bring a greater hope? Disparity?

## DIGGING DEEPER (Questions are taken from Serendipity Bible for Groups)

Read Romans 8:15-27

- In v. 17, what type of suffering does Paul have in view here? What do you think he means by the glory to come? How does this relate to what he says about creation (vv. 19-23)?
- What would a world like ours be like if there were no decay or death? No expectation or delay? How is this a picture of glory?
- What frustrates you most about living in a fallen world? How can the hope in vv. 22-25 help you during times of trial? What is the difference between hope and wishful thinking?

## APPLICATION

- How has this sermon and discussion shaped your perspective on heaven and how you should view eternal life?
- How do you know you will be in heaven some day? If you answered because you are a “good person”, then how do you know when being good is good enough?
- If there is someone in your group, or impact list, who believes that being good will get them into heaven, then discuss how they can be certain and pray for or with them.
