Position Summary:

County Line Church of God seeks a passionate and dedicated part-time Worship Leader to lead our congregations in spirit-filled worship. The ideal candidate will be a committed believer, an accomplished musician, and someone with a heart to inspire and lead others in worship through music. As a Worship Leader, you will be responsible for creating an atmosphere of worship that enhances the overall experience for the congregation during services and special events.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

The essential functions include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Plan, organize, and lead worship during weekly church services, including Sunday morning services, ministry events, and occasional special services.
- Attend weekly rehearsals with the worship team, ensuring musicians and vocalists are prepared for services.
- Execute worship sets as planned by the Creative Worship Arts Pastor at the assigned ministry area.
- Prepare in advance for each service to ensure worship is smooth.
- Willingness to serve at all County Line Campuses.
- Meets regularly with the Creative Worship Arts Pastor.
- Assists as needed with choir and various Creative Worship Arts groups.
- Ability to work on Sunday mornings and schedule rotation of evening ministry events.

Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities):

Education and Experience:

- Experience in worship leading.

Knowledge and Skills:

- Strong vocal ability with experience in leading congregational worship.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to work effectively in a team environment.
- Experience working with worship teams.

- Ability to play an instrument preferred but not required.
- Familiarity with modern worship music and worship planning software (e.g. Planning Center, ProPresenter, etc.)

Licenses, Registrations, and Certificates:

- Ability to drive various County Line Campuses

Spiritual Requirements:

- Recognizes Jesus as Lord and Savior and demonstrates that with a Christ-centered lifestyle.
- Agreement with County Line's Statement of Faith
- Adheres to County Line Staff Lifestyle agreement.

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to stand for at least 30 minutes at a time.
- Ability to lift 20-30 lbs.
