Part 2. Should I be Baptized now?

Baptism is something you will look back on for the rest of your life. Some parents prefer their children wait until they are in middle school or older to do that from a more mature understanding of the symbolic experience. Other parents allow their elementary children to be baptized when they begin asking about it and understand its meaning.

You and your parents should talk and decide together if you are ready, and if this is the right time for you to be baptized.

Here are some multiple choice questions, that will allow you to test your knowledge and understanding of baptism. Scriptures will be provided to help you find the answer if you do not know them.

1. What makes us right with God? (**Romans 3:22-24**)
